Waste Water: Oxidation ditch project is still ongoing. Keith Mulholland stated there is a meeting on Thursday with Helm Mechanical. He also reported Helm is still in the process of replacing the valves on the oxidation ditch and they will begin work on the clarifier next. FJF services will be starting on the 2nd influent pump and routine samples and testing and reports were done.

Drinking Water: IEPA is still reviewing the response letter regarding well 6, routine samples, testing and reports were done for the month, Peerless will start test well drilling May 23rd, the alarm systems have been updated and activated at Wells 9 & 10, 2021 water audit is complete. Keith reported Peerless has moved the date to start testing back to May 31st.

Work Report: 45 locates, 11 water meter changes, 18 water turn on/off, 2 valve box replacements.

Alderman Cahoe stated maybe some of the meter reading equipment needs to be updated.

Mayor Allhands stated he has put some information in the office from NextSite that the committee can take home and look at.
